HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE DECEMBER 2021 BOARD REORGANIZATION MEETING

Preceding the Board Reorganization meeting, the Oath of Office was administered to newly-elected and re-elected Board Members: Mrs. Cheryl Patalano, Mr. Stephen Mehlo, Mrs. Christine King, and Mrs. Amy Joy Robinson.

The Board approved the following items at their December 6, 2021 Board meeting:

- The Northgate Board of School Directors, at their Reorganization meeting, elected Mr. Michael Rajakovic as President and Mr. Daniel O'Keefe as Vice President.
- The Board also appointed the law firm of Andrews and Price, as represented by Patricia Andrews, to serve as the School District Solicitor.
- The Public meeting dates, times and location for 2022 were approved as shown on the attached.
- The Board identified <u>The Citizen</u>, Citizen Way, Bellevue, PA 15202, and the <u>Pittsburgh Post-Gazette</u>, 2201 Sweeney Dr., Clinton, PA 15026, as the official school newspapers, either of which may be used for legal advertisements.
- The Board appointed Mr. Daniel O'Keefe and Mrs. Christine King as representatives to the A.W. Beattie Career Center Committee. Also, any interested Board Member may serve and act on behalf of Northgate School District during the absence of appointed representatives.
- Approved Change Order Number GC-1 in regard to the Concrete Walk and Curb Replacement Project. The Change Order will reduce the total project cost by \$6,400 as a result of final contract adjustments for unused field quantity allowances. It will also increase the total by that same amount (\$6,400), the combined effect of adding a concrete walk and curb replacement and eliminating the asphalt patch width and bollard replacement at the High School and guardrail replacement at Avalon Elementary School. The net effect of the Change Order on the total project cost will be zero.
- Approved an athletic supplemental contract for the winter season of the 2021-22 school year (contingent upon the activity taking place) for Ed Marcellus as winter weightlifting sponsor in the amount of \$1,000.

- Approved Sean Halpate, Dan McKelvey and Lynn Hartle as volunteer swimming coaches.
- Ratified Chris Steiner as a part-time elementary lunchroom monitor at Bellevue Elementary.
- Approved Tyra Nelson as a substitute elementary lunchroom monitor.
- Ratified Martajah Reed, Kweilin Graham, Johnny Taggart and Charisse Witherspoon as bus drivers for W.L. Roenigk, Inc. for transporting students.
