HIGHLIGHTS FROM MARCH 2021 BOARD MEETINGS

Anna Jean Patalano, Student Council Representative, provided a Student Council update. She spoke about the recent Light Up Hope event where they raised more than \$1,000 and also collected food items. Anna Jean also mentioned some possible upcoming events that they are considering, such as Wish Day, Spirit Week and Trivia Night.

Superintendent's Report: Dr. Johns provided an update on Covid and vaccines. Mr. Rob King and Mr. Scott Kelly provided a presentation on the Technology E-Rate Project.

The Board approved the following items at their March 15, 2021 Board meeting:

- Approved an MOU with Crisis Center North for free mobile counseling services for K - 12 at no cost to the district.
- Approved the purchase of Smart Future Program in the amount of an annual cost of \$4,000.

- Approved the following volunteers for the spring musical: Kait Lorey as choreographer and Barb Gusew for costumes.
- Approved the District to contribute \$500 to Bellevue Borough toward maintenance of Bellevue Memorial Park for baseball, pending proof of purchase & supply.
- Approved James Coleman and Logan Parson as volunteer football coaches.
- Approved the February Treasurer's Report, and ratified the February 2021 Bill List.

- Approved a budget transfer of \$12,500 from account 325300 (Athletic Purchased Services) to account 325703 (Cardio Room Equipment) to purchase cardio equipment.
- Approved TruGreen Commercial to provide lawn care services at a cost of \$6,411.01, including fertilizer, weed control and vegetation control treatments at Alumni Stadium and the three school building grounds in the spring, summer and fall.
- Designated as unused and unnecessary and approve the disposal of a 2000 Chevy 3500 Stake Body truck.
- Approved the request of the Northgate Boys' Basketball Boosters to use the Middle/High School gym from 4:00 - 10:00 p.m. on May 3 - 6, 10 - 14, and 17 - 20, 2021 to hold a boys' basketball spring undergraduate tournament with all Covid protocols in place.
- Approved the second and final reading of the following policies:

- Approved funding for District network upgrades which have been approved and funded via the FCC E-rate program at a contribution rate of 20% by the District and 80% by the FCC E-rate program.
- Approved the adoption of the Allegheny Intermediate Unit's policies and procedures under the federal requirements of 34 CFR 300. The IU-adopted policies and procedures are implemented to fulfill the requirements of 22 Pa. Code, Chapter 14 and the regulatory requirements under the individuals with Disabilities Education Act - Part B.
